Dear Parents,

Frost Elementary will continue to be a **MANDATORY UNIFORM SCHOOL** during the 2007-2008 school year. Below you will find the uniform policy and guidelines for the school. Mandatory uniforms will be more strictly enforced. Please ensure that your children participate in the uniform guidelines. Research has shown that schools that have uniform policies demonstrated greater student achievement than other schools. The clothes are available at stores such as Target, WalMart, Sears, J.C. Penney, Ave Maria, and Bealls.

**MANDATORY SCHOOL UNIFORMS:** Students are to wear the school uniforms, Monday thru Friday. Friday is designated as Spirit Day and students are encouraged to wear their spirit/school T-shirt on that day with jeans. Spirit shirts may be worn from a previous school until Frost shirts become available. There will be special dress days during the school year. These days will be announced in the monthly school bulletin and on the morning show.

Students do not have to wear uniforms on picture days, but dress must be in accordance with the Hillsborough County dress code. On field trip days, a spirit shirt may be worn instead of a uniform shirt.

The uniform for Frost students consists of:

**SHIRTS:**

White, navy blue, royal blue, gold or yellow polo style shirts with collar with or without school logo. Shirts with logo may be ordered through the Frost PTA at the beginning of the school year. When wearing the school uniform, no logo or writing other than the school logo is allowed on shirts.

**PANTS/WALKING SHORTS:**

Khaki or navy blue pants.  
Khaki or navy blue walking shorts. Shorts should be mid-thigh length.  
**All pants are to be worn at the waist and belted, if necessary.**  
Jeans may only be worn on Fridays with spirit shirts.

**SKIRTS, SKORTS OR JUMPERS:**

Khaki or navy blue skirts/skort  
Khaki or navy blue or blue plaid jumpers  
Collared shirts are to be worn under jumpers

**SHOES:**

Tennis shoes and socks are recommended as students will participate in daily physical education activities. District policy requires that shoes be closed toe and closed back with a hard sole. Shoes should have no distractors, i.e. lights, sound, or wheels.

**JEWELRY:**

Parents must monitor the wearing of jewelry keeping and keep in mind the risk of theft and breakage.
